A	No action required.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sampled compartment is within expected limits based on supplied information. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continue recommended servicing procedures.
B	Minor corrective action or more information is required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sampled compartment or oil condition is showing indication of early wear or oil degradation. This evaluation may also be utilised when insufficient information is supplied on the sample registration card. Poor sampling technique may be suspected. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Evaluate equipment operating conditions. A reduced oil change interval may be required. Minor repair or inspection may be warranted. A resample may be required to confirm compartment condition.
C	Abnormal wear or oil condition has occurred; corrective action is required.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wear indicators/elements indicate a likely reduced component service life due to abnormal conditions. Oil quality/condition has been severely compromised. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Priority should be given to investigate compartment condition with view to repair as required. Usually a sample will be required to confirm repairs have been successfully completed.
X	Extreme wear or critical oil degradation has occurred; immediate corrective action is required.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wear levels indicate an extreme reduction in compartment service life or catastrophic failure is imminent. Oil condition/quality is severely compromised. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An immediate investigation into the issue is required. Equipment should not be operated until repairs have been completed.
